Philately 101 (pronounced fə · lat' · ə · lē) is an introduction to the collection and study of postage stamps, postal items, and postal history. This class will be hosted by Steve Stiff on Saturday, March 7th, from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. (or longer). The class will look at the history of the postage stamp, the how and why of collecting stamps, the various methods to mount and store stamps, how to identify stamps, and how to use a stamp catalogue to determine the value of stamps.
